

Minnesota DFL Party Precinct Caucus Absentee Letter

This is a sample letter used by those who cannot attend the local precinct caucus. Although you cannot vote absentee, you can petition to be nominated in the delegate election process. Your name will be entered into nomination at the same time as others, and your fellow caucus attendees can elect you to represent them at the senate district convention.
